





What is "Young Farmers"?


- Young Farmers or YFC is a fantastic organisation for 10 to 28 year olds.






 Yorkshire YFC feeds into Northern Area, made up of the 7 northern counties


 All affiliated to National Federation, a group of nearly 600 clubs and 23,000 members across England & Wales National






How YFC is run – what makes us unique

- Democracy!






Digital Membership

- 100% online sign up process
- https://nfyfc-staging.azurewebsites.net/
- Multi-step Process
 - Member/Parent to complete member details
 - Nominate Parent/Guardian contact
 - Parent receives email with link to complete
 - Member pays club fees
 - Club confirm receipt and approve
 - County Office complete
 - Member to download membership card
- 764 members completed





Digital Card




Download Member Card




Top Tips

- Don't leave it until last minute!













