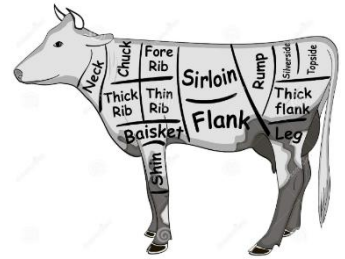




## YORKSHIRE FEDERATION OF YOUNG FARMERS' CLUBS

**DATE:** Sunday 19<sup>th</sup> October 2025.

**VENUE:** J&E Medcalf Ltd, Brockwoods Industrial Estate

**REPORT:** Report to J&E Medcalf Ltd at 9.30am for a 10.00am prompt start. (Judges/Stewards to register at 9.00am)

**ELIGIBILITY:** Competitors must be 28 years and under on 1st September 2025. Competitors must show a **current** YFC membership card. Competitors under 18 must show a signed parental consent form and competitors aged 18+ must have a second form of ID.

**CLASSES AT COUNTY:** 21 & Under and 28 & Under.

Please note: At the National Final on Saturday 15th/Sunday 16th November 2025 at the English Winter Fair, the competitors age ranges are 21 & Under and 28 & Under and County qualifiers will be scored using these age ranges.

**CLOTHING:** Competitors to provide their own white coat and tie, clean boots to be worn whilst judging the carcasses. County will provide hair nets and hand sanitiser.

**PROCEDURE:** Competitors will be required to judge 4 live lambs and give reasons **or** judge 4 live beef cattle and give reasons. Competitors will be required judge 4 lamb carcasses **or** 4 beef carcasses and give reasons. Competitors to choose one stock they are judging at time of entering. Animals in each ring will be designated A, B, X, Y. Competitors will also be required to place the beef or lamb livestock and carcasses in order of merit and estimate/classify their classification according to the Meat & Livestock Commission Services Limited (MLCSL) Carcase Classification Scheme.

**TIMING:** Competitors will be allowed 10 minutes to judge the ring of stock and 5 minutes for preparing cards and handing to stewards. Competitors will be allowed up to 2 minutes for stating their reasons on the ring of stock to the Judge. Competitors exceeding this time limit will incur penalties at the rate of 2 marks for each 15 seconds or part thereof. The marks to be deducted from their total score.

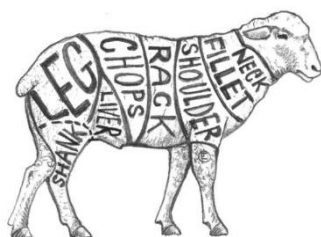

**ROUNDS:** Successful competitors (21 & under and 28 & under) will be required to go forward to compete in the NFYFC Finals at the English Winter Fair, Staffordshire Showground, held on 15<sup>th</sup> & 16<sup>th</sup> November 2025.
