

STOCKMAN OF THE YEAR

DATE: Saturday 28th February 2026.

VENUE: CCM Auction Mart, Gargrave Road, Skipton, BD23 1UD.

REPORT: 9.00am to start competitions at 9.20am prompt.

DAIRY VENUE: To be confirmed.

ELIGIBILITY: Competitors must be 28 years and under on 1st September 2025.

Competitors need to be very clear about which age category they are entering. They will not be able to move/swap after entries have closed. Reminder: If you are 18/were 18 on 1st September 2025 you can still enter the 18 and under. Competitors aged 18 and under may also move up to the 28 and under category if they wish however will not be able to move back down/swap after entries have closed.

PROCEDURE: Competitors will be required to judge four rings of stock (6 Dairy, 6 Beef Cattle, 6 Breeding Ewes and 6 Butchers Pigs/Lambs) and give reasons on all rings of stock. Animals in each ring will be designated A, B, C, X, Y, Z. Competitors will also be required to complete an Animal Health & Husbandry questionnaire. Competitors may be questioned on the role of a Stockman.

TIMING: Competitors will be allowed 15 minutes to observe each ring of 6 stock and at least 5 minutes to prepare reasons. Competitors will be allowed up to 3 minutes for stating their reasons on each ring of 6 stock to the judge. Competitors who exceed these time limits will incur penalties at the rate of two marks for each fifteen seconds or part thereof. The marks will be deducted from their total score. Competitors will be allowed a maximum of 30 minutes to complete the Animal Health and Husbandry Questionnaire.
