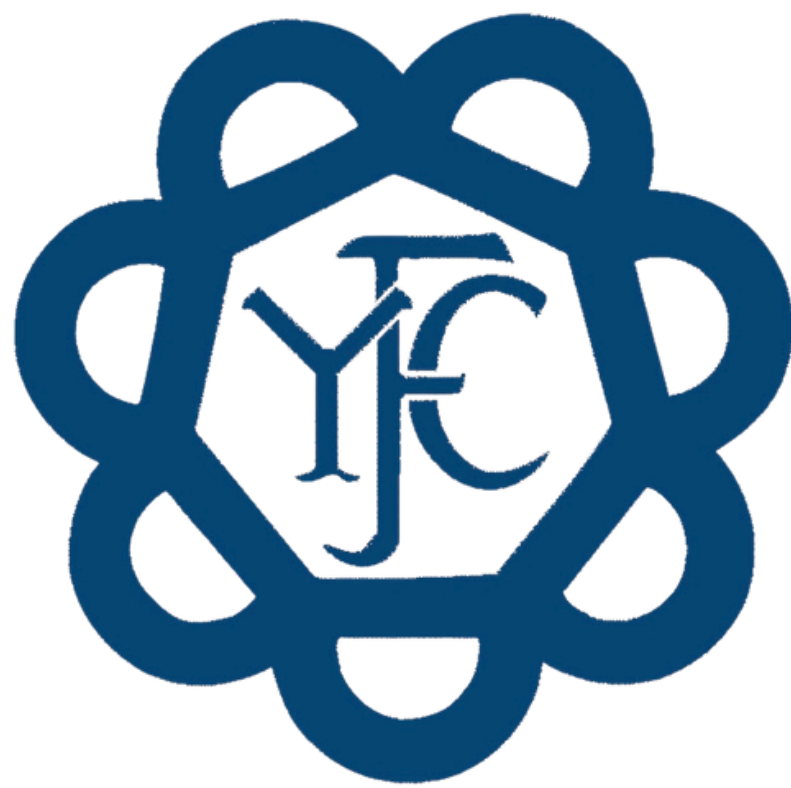

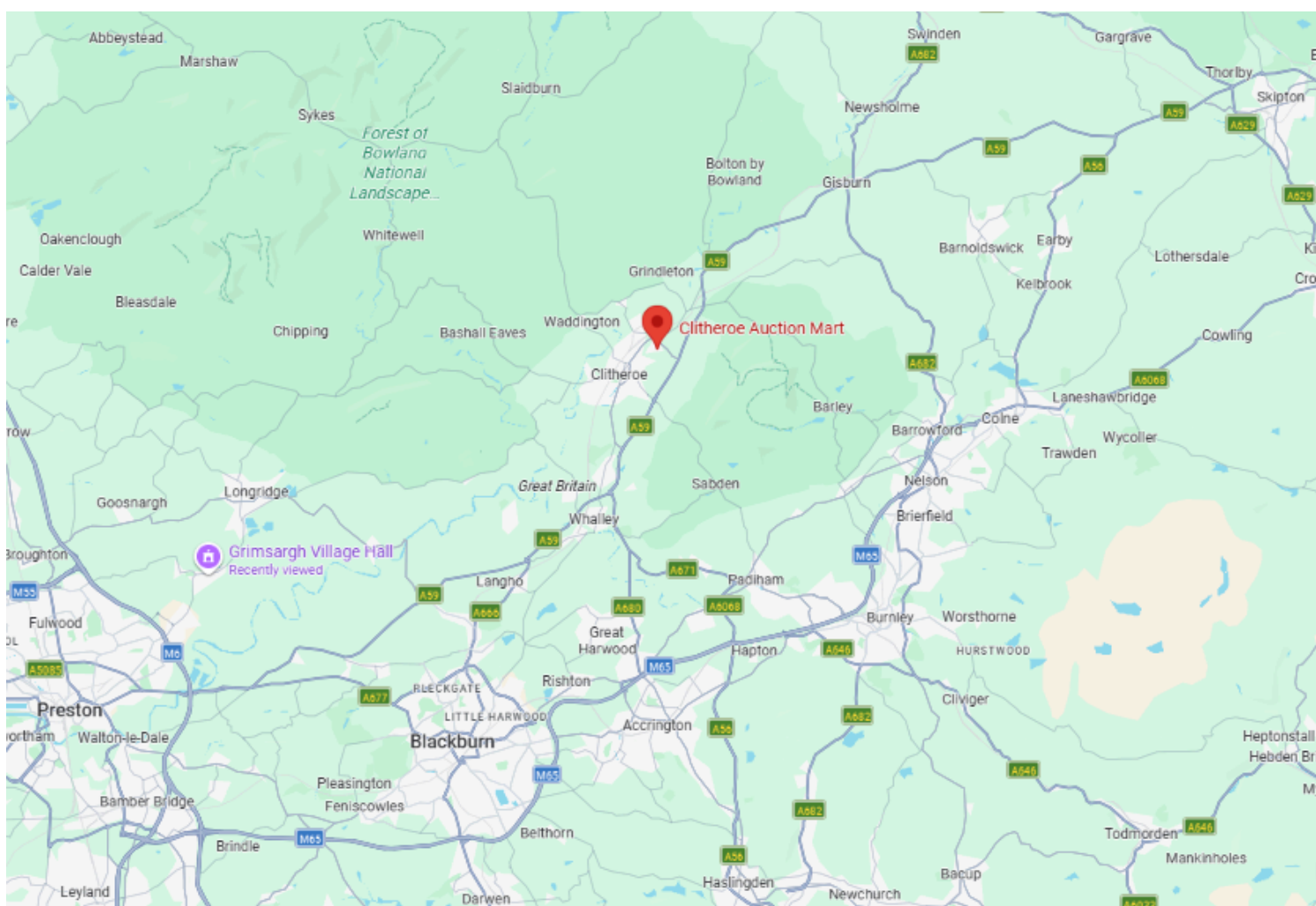

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From the A59 turn on to Pimlico Link Road.

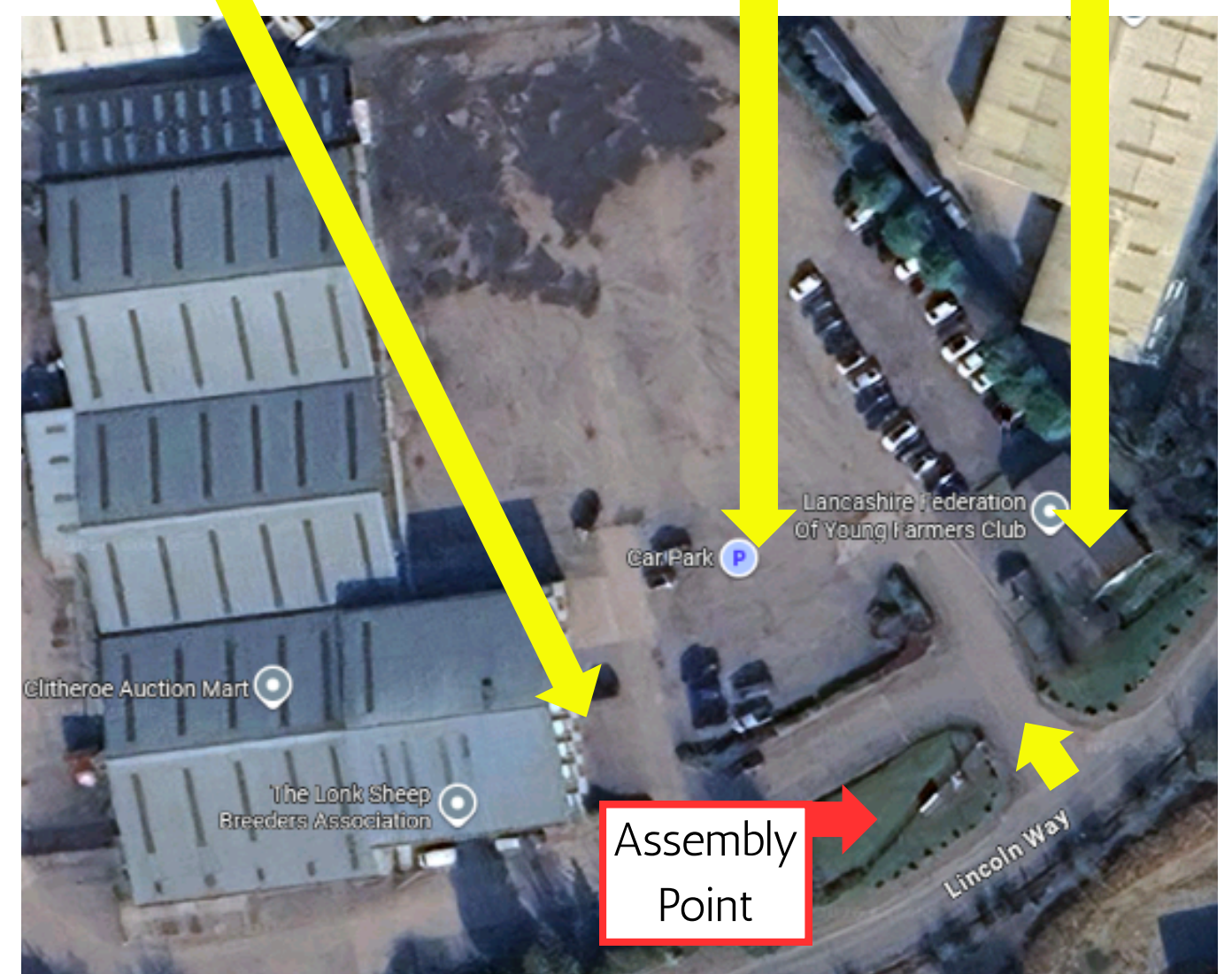
Take the next left on to Lincoln way and then turn right into the car park of the Auction Mart.
